1. MPO OVERVIEW

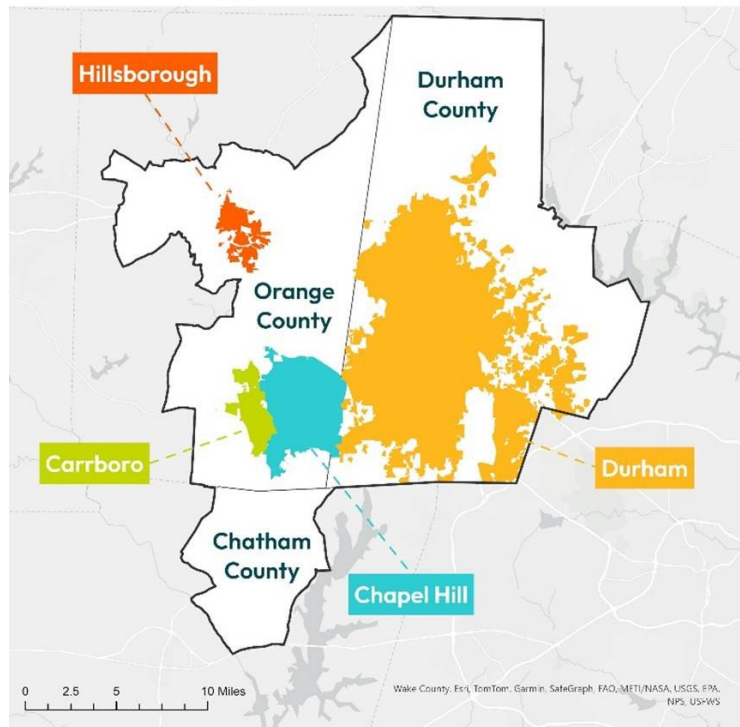
The Triangle West Transportation Planning Organization (Triangle West TPO) is the designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the western part of the Research Triangle and is responsible for carrying out a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive (“3-C”) transportation planning process in accordance with federal and state requirements.

The Triangle West TPO planning area includes all of Durham County, a portion of Orange County (including the Towns of Chapel Hill, Carrboro, and Hillsborough), and Northeast Chatham County. The metropolitan area boundary encompasses the existing urbanized area and the contiguous area expected to become urbanized within the 20-year forecast period.

The TPO’s work program and key actions are supported through a Technical Committee process that reviews draft materials and makes recommendations for Board action. The Triangle West TPO Policy Board includes elected officials and representatives from the City of Durham, Durham County, the Towns of Carrboro, Chapel Hill, and Hillsborough, Orange County, Chatham County, the North Carolina Board of Transportation, and GoTriangle (regional transit representative).

On January 28, 2025, the Policy Board voted to change the organization’s name from the Durham–Chapel Hill–Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization (DCHC MPO) to the Triangle West Transportation Planning Organization to better represent the TPO’s constituent communities; previously adopted documents may still reflect the former name.

Because the Triangle West TPO covers an urbanized area with a population over 200,000 (a Transportation Management Area, or TMA), FHWA and FTA conduct a full federal certification review every four years.

The most recent certification review was conducted in fall 2021, and FHWA completed its certification review report in June 2022, finding the Triangle West TPO's planning process to be certified.

2. ABOUT THIS REPORT

This report is Triangle West TPO’s annual listing of federally authorized and obligated transportation projects within the Triangle West TPO planning area. It is intended to provide a clear public record of project delivery and the use of federal transportation funds during the most recent federal fiscal year (October 1, 2024–September 30, 2025).

Federal-aid transportation projects move through several steps, and two terms show up often:

- Authorization generally means a project phase has been approved for federal participation (i.e., it is eligible to seek reimbursement for allowable costs).
- Obligation is the point when the federal government makes a legal commitment to reimburse an eligible recipient for the federal share of project costs.

Because of how projects are delivered and billed, the dollar amount shown as “obligated” in a given year may not match the total project cost or the amount that was programmed in the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for that year.

Additionally, obligations can include adjustments, and funds can sometimes be returned when they are not needed at the end of a project phase (a “de-obligation”).

2.1 Federal Guidance

Federal regulations require MPOs to publish an annual listing of projects for which federal funds were obligated in the preceding year.

In preparing this report, Triangle West TPO follows FHWA/FTA guidance to present the information in a user-friendly format, while coordinating with the agencies that track project authorizations and obligations.

2.2 Transportation Improvement Program

Triangle West TPO’s Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) is the adopted, fiscally constrained program of transportation investments for the region. The FY2026–2035 TIP meets federal requirements (including 23 CFR 450.334(a)) and depicts the region’s priorities for the expenditure of federal funds during federal fiscal years 2026–2035.

The TIP includes projects across multiple modes (highway, transit, bicycle and pedestrian, rail, and other programs) and must be consistent with the adopted Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).

The Triangle West TIP is also coordinated with North Carolina's State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP); both documents cover a 10-year period, with the first four years generally considered the "delivery" program.

3. SUMMARY OF FY 2025 OBLIGATED PROJECTS

The TPO tracks the obligated funds for transportation projects within the Triangle West TPO Planning Area. The total FHWA fund obligation for FY 2025 was **\$94,386,816.00**, of which **\$7,867,316.00** was obligated for projects in the TPO counties alone (not including statewide and multi-county projects that extend outside the Triangle West TPO Planning Area boundary). **\$2,635,396.00** in FHWA funding was obligated for projects in Chatham County, **\$-427,639.00** was obligated for projects in Durham County, **\$5,659,559.00** was obligated for projects in Orange County. The total FTA fund obligation for Triangle West TPO in 2025 was **\$5,510,728.00**. Compared to 2024, in which the total FHWA funding obligation was **\$220,499,583.80**, and the FTA funding obligation was **\$5,578,409.00**, the total amount obligated federal funds obligated for FY 2025 decreased.

Table 1 shows the breakdown of FY 2024 funding obligations by project type. Section 4 includes a complete list of the FY 2025 federally obligated projects.

Figure 1 compares the amount of funding authorized by project type/category, which includes statewide, division only, and projects for which Triangle West TPO is included. Most of the funding obligated was for projects in the Safety and ITS/Signal/Roundabout and other mitigation projects category.

Figure 2 shows the funds authorized by project type/category, specifically within Triangle West Counties alone (Chatham, Durham and Orange). Most of the funding obligated was for projects in the Bicycle/Pedestrian and other enhancement projects (\$6,323,336). The next highest category for which funding was obligated was in Planning (\$4,095, 871). The Planning category includes funding for special studies and other Triangle West TPO planning activities. The Roadway category shows a negative balance because there was a large project, I-85 Pavement Rehabilitation from the ORANGE COUNTY LINE TO US 15 / US 501 IN DURHAM that shows a negative balance of \$-13,110,920.

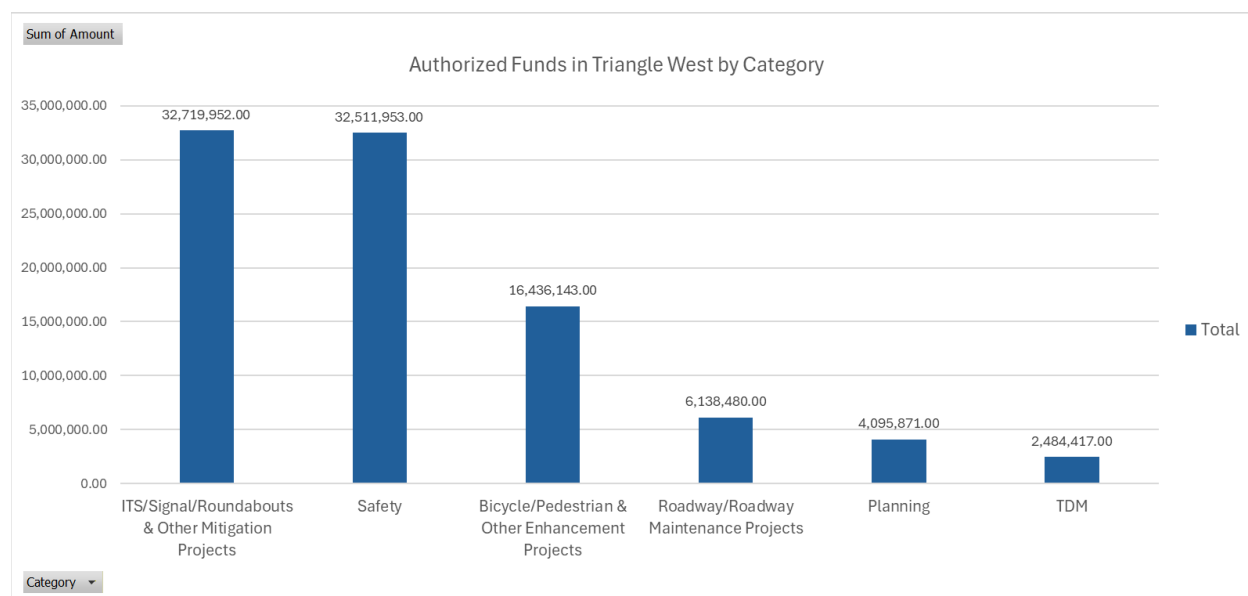

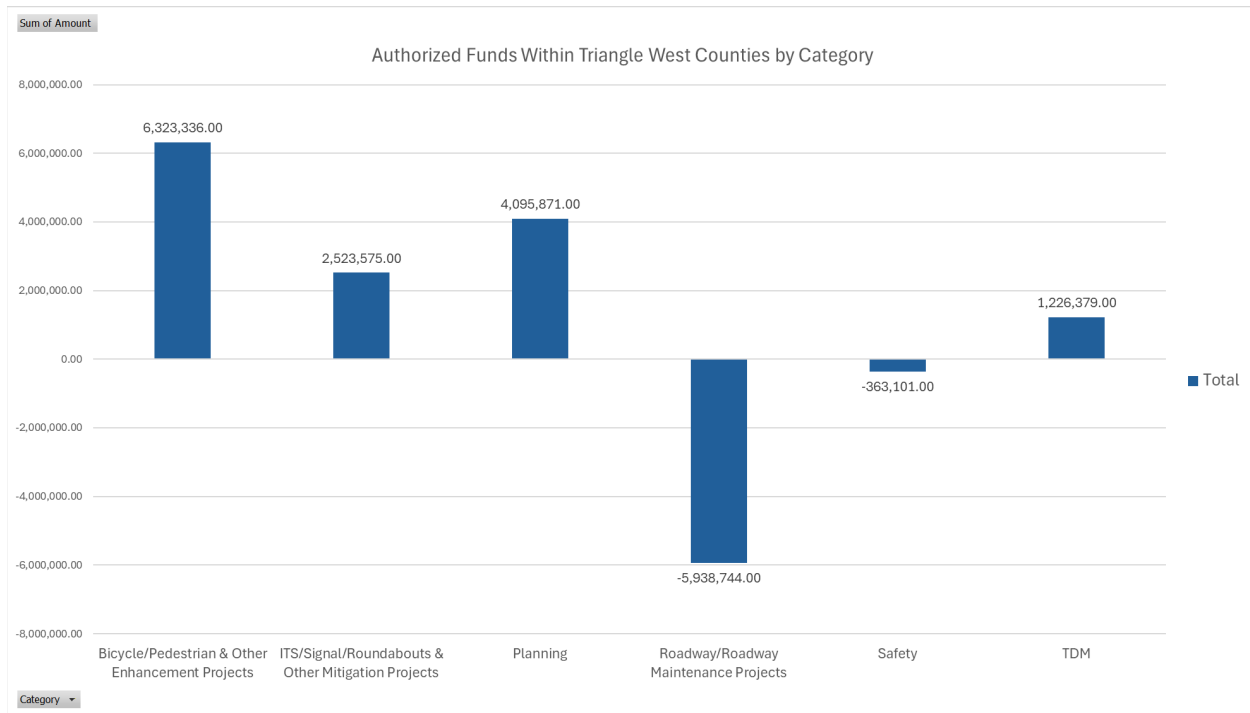

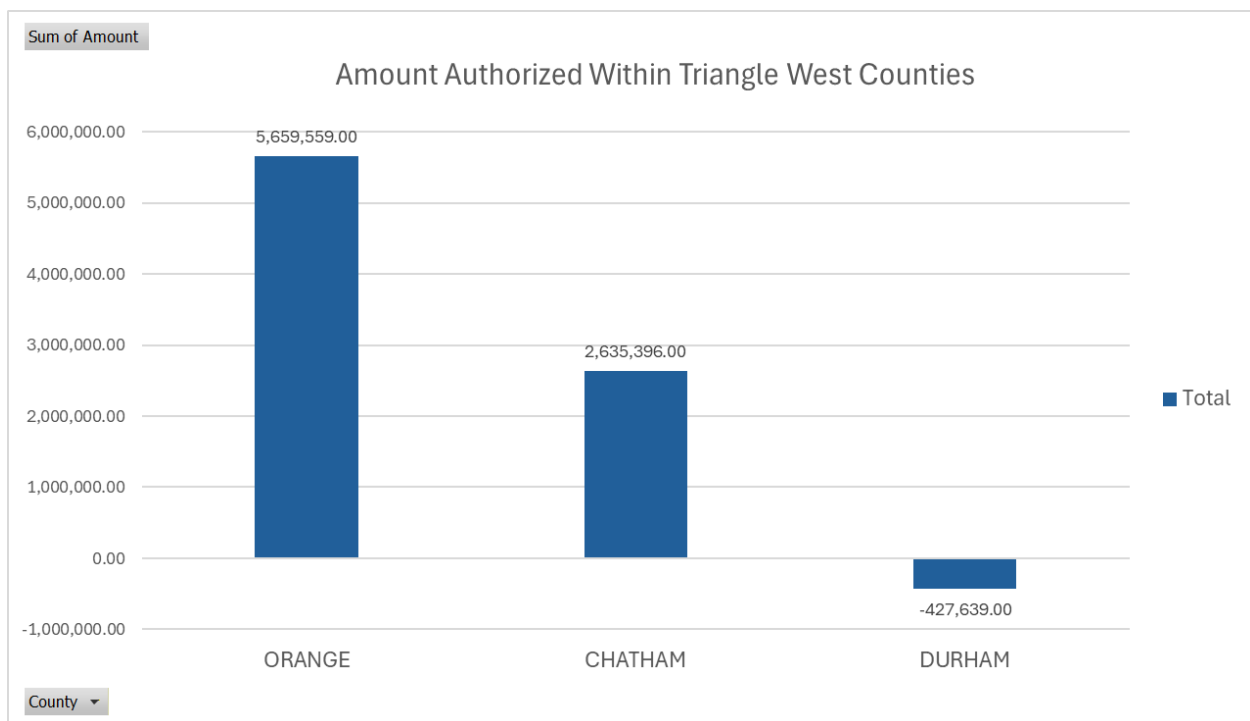


Figure 3 shows the total amount of funding authorized specifically for projects in Triangle West TPO counties (Chatham, Durham and Orange). This chart excludes statewide and division only projects. Durham shows a negative balance because of the I-85 pavement reconstruction project previously mentioned. Figure 4 shows the amount of funding authorized by mode for the Triangle West Planning area, which includes statewide and division only projects. Most of the funding was spent on Highway projects. Looking at projects in Triangle West counties only, Figure 5 shows the amount of funding authorized in Triangle West Counties alone by mode. Most of the funding obligated was spent on Bicycle and Pedestrian projects. This is consistent of the direction of the Triangle West TPO Board and 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan.

Looking specifically at FTA funded projects, Figure 6 shows the transit funds authorized in Triangle West by County. There were several projects that were multi-county projects that extend outside the Triangle West TPO planning area boundary, which are included in the chart.

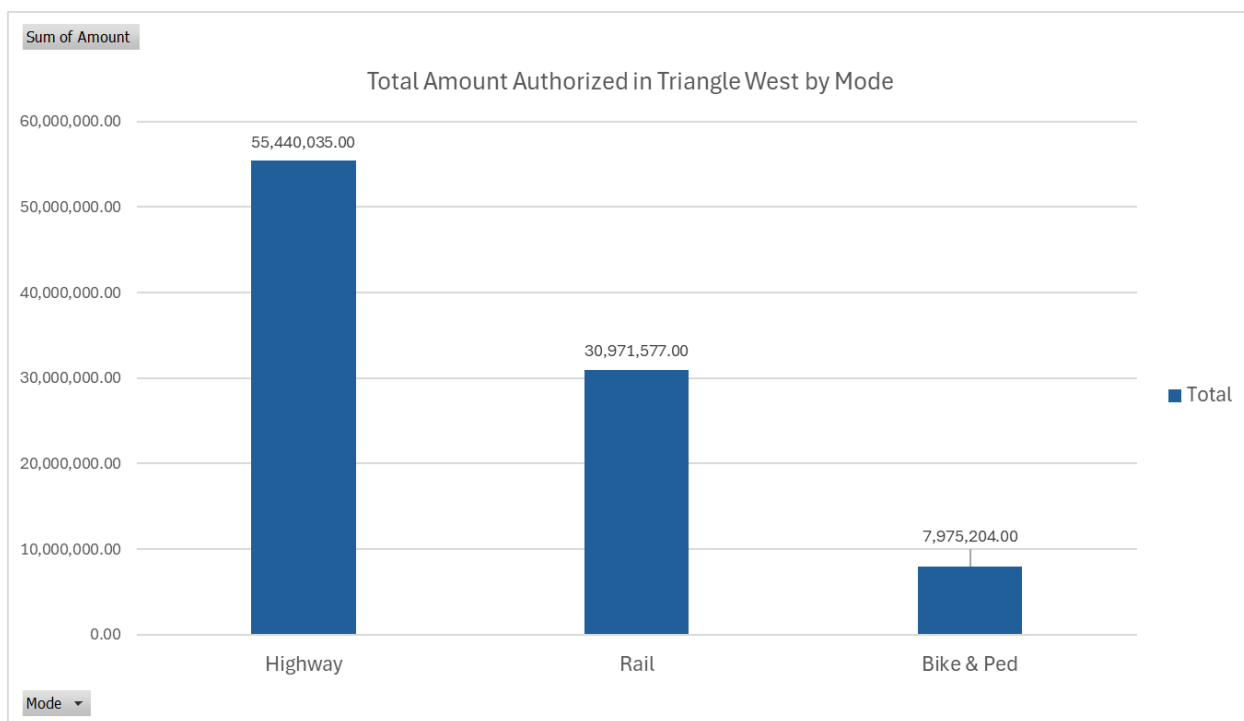

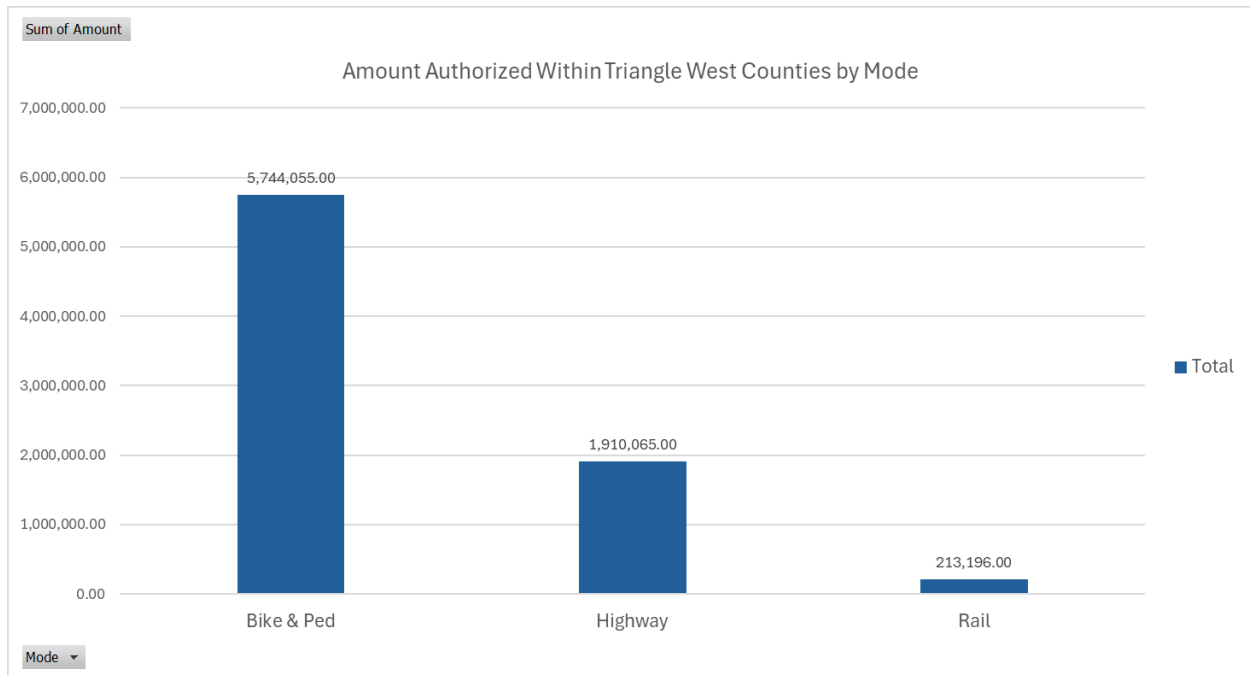
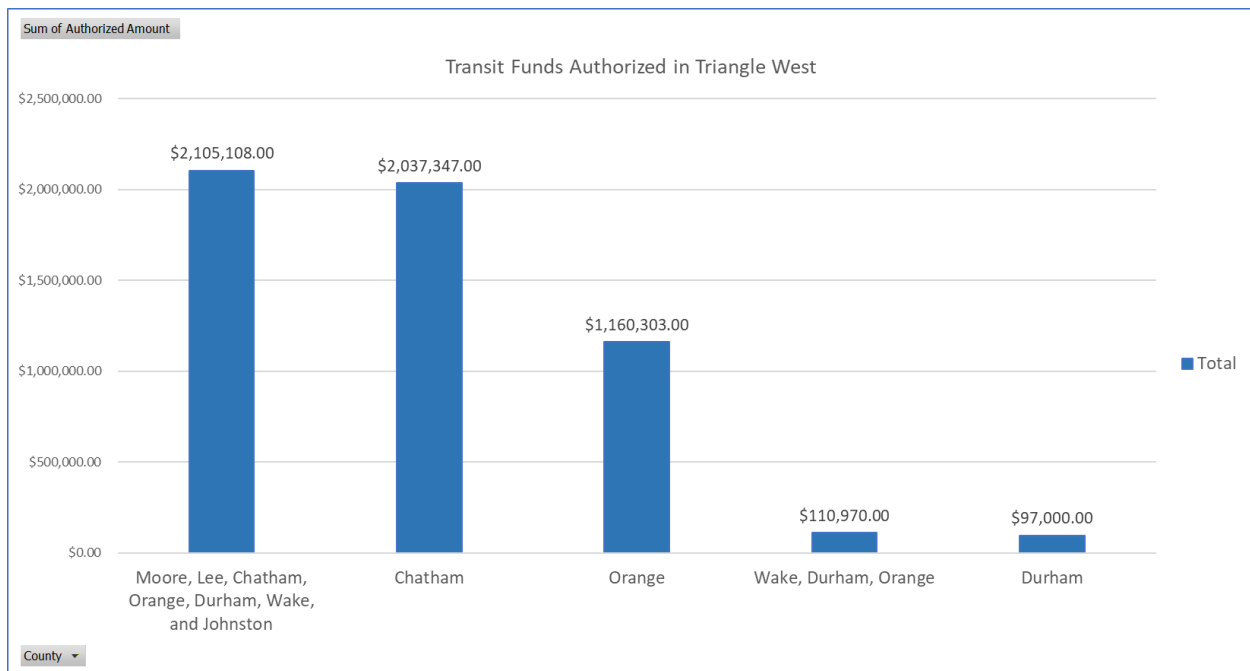

5. EXPLANATION OF FUNDING SOURCES

Funding Sources

Following are the funding sources referenced in the FY 2025 list of federally obligated projects.

FEDERAL HIGHWAY ADMINISTRATION (FHWA) FUNDS

National Highway Performance Program (NHPP)

Provides formula funding to support the condition and performance of the National Highway System (NHS), including preservation and eligible improvements on NHS routes.

Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBG)

Provides flexible formula funding that can be used on a wide range of transportation projects to address State and local transportation needs.

Transportation Alternatives (TA) Set-Aside

Sets aside a portion of each State's STBG funds for smaller-scale projects such as pedestrian and bicycle facilities, safe routes, and other eligible community-based transportation improvements.

Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Improvement Program

Provides funding for transportation projects and programs that reduce congestion and improve air quality, especially in air quality nonattainment and maintenance areas.

Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)

Provides funding for data-driven safety strategies and safety improvement projects intended to significantly reduce traffic fatalities and serious injuries on public roads.

National Highway Freight Program (NHFP)

Provides funding to improve freight movement and performance on designated freight networks and other eligible freight-related infrastructure.

Carbon Reduction Program (CRP)

Provides funding for projects and strategies that reduce transportation-related emissions, including eligible operational, multimodal, and system efficiency improvements.

National Electric Vehicle Infrastructure (NEVI) Formula Program

Provides funding to strategically deploy publicly accessible EV charging infrastructure, including designated Alternative Fuel Corridors and consistent with State deployment plans.

Bridge Formula Program (BFP)

Provides formula funding to replace, rehabilitate, preserve, protect, and construct highway bridges.

FEDERAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY (FTA) FUNDS

Metropolitan Planning and Statewide Planning Program (Sections 5303 and 5304)

Provides funding and procedural requirements for multimodal transportation planning in metropolitan areas and states that are cooperative, continuous and comprehensive, resulting in long-range plans and shortrange programs that reflect transportation investment priorities. These planning programs are jointly administered by FTA and the FHWA, which provides additional funding to MPOs.

Urban Area Formula Program (Section 5307)

Makes Federal resources available to qualifying areas for transit capital, operating assistance, and transportation planning in MPOs and urbanized areas with a population of 50,000 or more as designated by the U.S. Department of Commerce, Bureau of the Census.

Enhanced Mobility of Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities Program (Section 5310)

Improve mobility for seniors and individuals with disabilities by removing barriers to transportation service and expanding transportation mobility options. This program supports transportation services planned, designed, and carried out to meet the special transportation needs of seniors and individuals with disabilities in all areas – large urbanized (over 200,000 population), small urbanized (50,000–200,000 population), and rural (under 50,000 population). Eligible projects include both traditional capital

investment and nontraditional operational assistance investment beyond the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) complementary paratransit services.

Bus and Bus Facilities Program (Section 5339)

Provides capital funding to replace, rehabilitate and purchase buses and related equipment and to construct bus-related facilities.

Capital Investment Grant (CIG) Program (Section 5309)

This FTA discretionary grant program funds transit capital investments, including heavy rail, commuter rail, light rail, streetcar and bus rapid transit. Federal transit law requires transit agencies seeking CIG funding to complete a series of steps over several years. For New Starts and Core Capacity projects, the law requires completion of two phases in advance of receipt of a construction grant agreement – Project Development and Engineering. For Small Starts projects, the law requires completion of one phase in advance of receipt of a construction grant agreement – Project Development. This FTA funding is not administered by IMD.
