Q: Do new projects have to be in the CTP?

A: Projects must be identified in either the MTP or another locally adopted plan.

Q: How is design funded? Only after 30%?

A: The 30% is a typo. Funding for design may be requested in the same manner as other phases.

Q: Are there any concerns on the future of funding sources?

A: Nothing to cause concern has been officially confirmed. We have been taking actions to be more proactive with spending our money to prepare for the worst.

Q: If the County were to partner with NCDOT to supplement funds on a project to improve bike-pedestrian accommodations, how would that work?

A: We would first need to talk through and determine the level of coordination that would be required.

Q: Are transit maintenance facilities eligible projects?

A: Yes, transit capital projects are permitted to apply for funds.

Q: Will the slides, Federal Funding Policy, and supporting documentation templates be sent out?

Q: What about regulatory or permitting review?

A: The municipality is responsible for submitting their project to any applicable agency. This can be done at any point between the start of the project and when plans are expected to be completed.

Q: If using on-call or in-house PE do you need to provide an estimate/proposal to NCDOT as an audit prior to getting underway to allow for reimbursement?
